What has SWORA been up to this past year ?

The Covid 19 pandemic has put SWORA in a large vacuum without the ability to hold meetings, and do a lot of the activities that we normally do over the year. The SWORA board has been busy keeping things moving forward the best we can. Since our First Wednesday in June 2020 Membership Meeting was not able to be held, an Emergency was declared and the decision was made to keep the current board in place. That allowed us to be able to continue to do business until a election could be held.

We currently only have a small amount of our members signed up, so communicating with everyone on a large scale has been difficult for us. The SWORA board has met 4 times this past year. We have had a few unexpected surprises come our way. The big one was that we had a break-in on Baldy Butte and found that SWORA lost a large batter. The vandals used a battery power cut off grinder and cut around the lock, a new door was ordered by the state.

SWORA has had some on going issues with Winchester Hill building (the building is 53 years old and is a short life trailer, time to move on) the board decided to go ahead and replace the building with a new concrete and block building. The Douglas County planning Dept has giving SWORA the go ahead. Butch Schroder, a building designer drew up plans for a new build and then sent them off to Stuart Wood architect, the plans will be finished by end of May, then off to the Douglas County Building dept for approval. SWORA has a contractor ready to go upon approval. Since this site provides the majority of our yearly income, the building along with a new lease for Silke Communications for Winchester Hill became our highest priorities. At some point the building will be constructed then comes the work, painting inside and out, moving the equipment and coax at the same time for shortest outage time.


NORTH




PRE-ENGINEERED


NEW BUILDING
