SWORA has had some issues going on with Winchester Hill building (the building is 53 years old and is a short life trailer, time to move on) the board decided to go ahead and replace the building with a new concrete and block building to meet Homeland Security requirements. Currently we are waiting on Douglas County Building Dept. for a building permit giving SWORA the go ahead. Stuart Wood architect, has finished drawing the plans. Then off to the Douglas County Building Dept for approval. SWORA has a contractor on retainer ready to go upon approval. Since this site provides the majority of our yearly income, a new building for Winchester Hill became our highest priority. At some point the building will be finished, then comes the work, painting inside and out, moving the equipment and coax at the same time for shortest outage time. We are located in a forest zone so we have to meet fire and security with cement block and no windows.

It will also give more space to add new radios and room to move around.

2023 Repeater Updates.

With the new building costs rising everyday we made the decision to not spend a lot of money on new items. We did update the 147.180 repeater on Winchester Hill to one of the newer GE Master III's in January.

We were lucky enough to receive a new set of solar panels for Bosley Butte. A new mount and some building work will be required before we can install them.






SWORA VHF Link System Diagram
